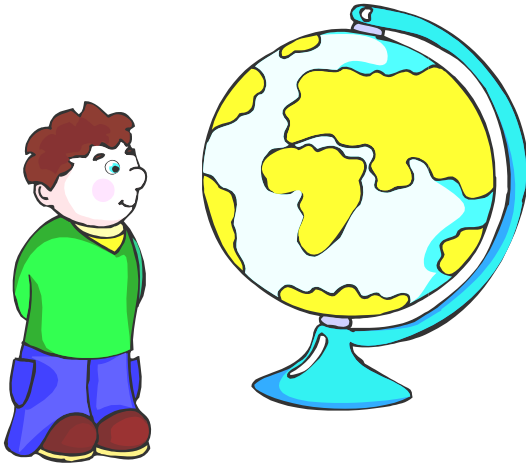


# Think of arguments
